Responsibilities

- Serve on the YPC for one (1) year with an option to renew at the end of the year
- Act as an advocate for NANPP in the community and through social media
- Increase awareness of and support for the NANPP mission
- Attend at least four (4) formal meetings with Board leadership and/or other NANPP membership in attendance
- Host at least one (1) fundraising event (collectively/as an entity) for NANPP
- Participate in at least two (2) service/volunteer days with a NANPP member
- Actively support NANPP fundraising events and national conference
- Attend 80% of YPC meetings, conference calls and contribute input and feedback
- Sign and adhere to the organization's conflict of interest policy and code of ethics
- Give and/or get others to contribute a minimum of \$500 per year
